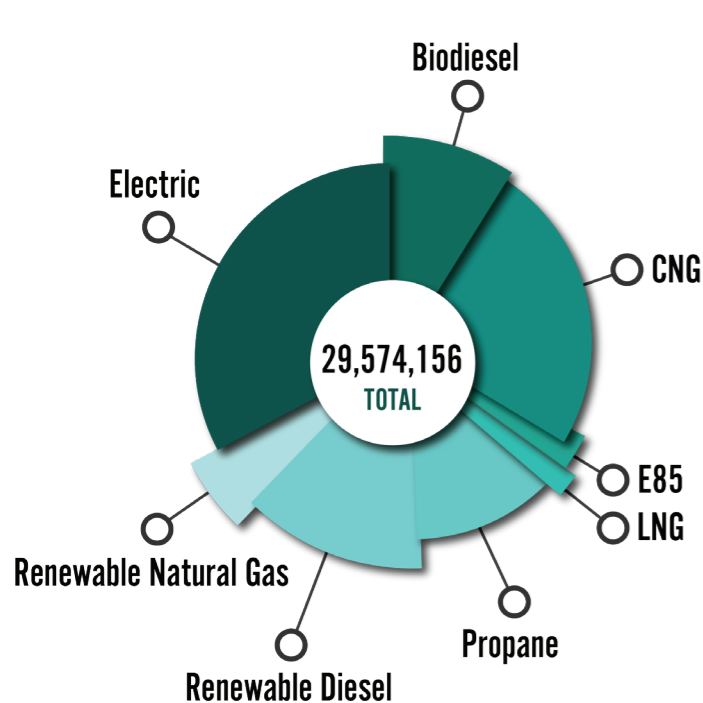
WHO WE ARE: STEERING INNOVATION

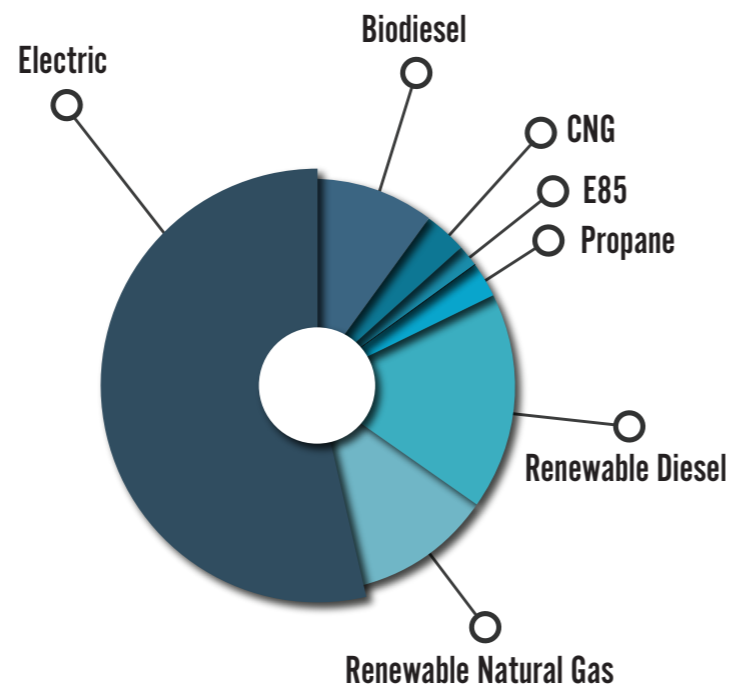
WHAT WE DO
